

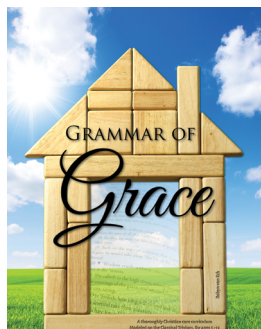

MEMORY LESSONS

The Reformers and early Americans taught children English through the Word of God!

Classical education always “multi-tasked” by teaching theology, morality, and good character in the children’s school lessons—so that children would be equipped *mind and soul* to live their lives well.

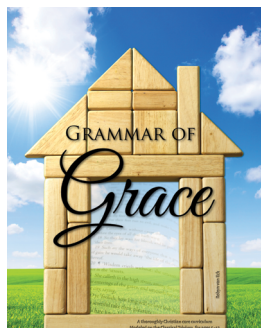
They learn vocabulary, excellent literary structure, and complex logical formulations, at their level, through *rote memorization*—which is easy and natural for them at this age! We fill their minds with treasures, which provides a rich store for them to draw from, for the rest of their lives.

The *Grammar of Grace* memory lessons are presented in 7 subjects:

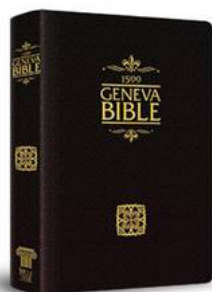
- Bible verses
- Longer Bible passages
- Scripture Catechism
- Verses in Latin, Greek, or Hebrew
- History Quotations
- Christian Worldview Timeline
- English Literature (Poetry/Hymns)

There are 24 weeks in each cycle, and 4 cycles. Ideally, each child cycles through *Grammar of Grace* twice, beginning at age 5, so he not only memorizes each lesson the first time, but reviews it several years later, transferring it into his long-term memory.

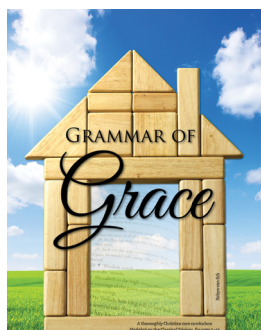

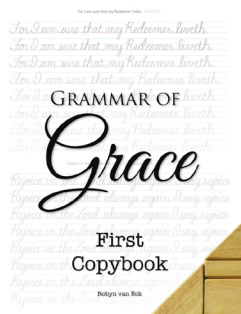
DAILY BIBLE READING

CLASSICAL EDUCATION WAS NOT RIGOROUS FOR YOUNG CHILDREN

Children should be taught to read using phonics, taught how to write through copywork, read to from the Bible, and made to memorize lots and lots and lots of excellent scriptures and Christian writings.

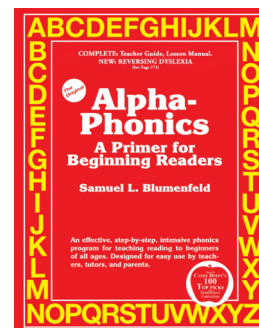
That was the education plan for children back in the days of Christian education, and it worked! The Classical Trivium works!

PHONICS

The Grammar of Grace education includes teaching your children to read the Christian, classical way—the method that, today, we call phonics.

Grammar of Grace was created to supply needs that no other curriculum fulfills. So even though it would be fun to create a Bible-based phonics curriculum, you can get the job done with a great curriculum like *Alpha-Phonics* and supplement with the Bible.

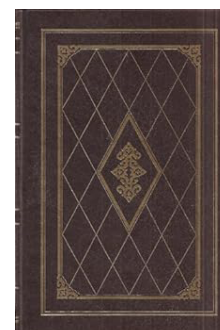
Use a true phonics curriculum.

GREAT BOOKS

During all of the extra time you'll have, not forcing your children to complete an endless stream of worksheets, read great books to your children.

Not *Charlotte's Web* and *Winnie the Pooh*—where no one is a sinner, no one needs God, and there is no God in the universe of the story, anyway. Read the kinds of books that Charles Spurgeon's and Noah Webster's parents read to them—like *The Pilgrim's Progress* and Foxe's *Book of Martyrs*. Children back in those days loved hearing real books read to them, and our children are no different!

GREAT BOOKS



Read great Christian books like *The Pilgrim's Progress* (unabridged) and Foxe's *Book of Martyrs* (1800s edition).
